"AJ Fresh"

Aaron John McDowell, affectionately known as "AJ Fresh" to his friends and fans, was born on October 6, 1982, from the union of Elder Larry (deceased) and Adriane McDowell on the South Side of Chicago. The youngest of six children, Aaron was a source of joy and energy, his childhood marked by early mornings filled with cartoons, playing with action figures, sports, and video games. Although initially quiet and laid back, he would often surprise people by displaying his dancing talent. Aaron's loyalty and warmth cultivated lifelong friendships that stood the test of time. Terrance Dobbs remained his best friend since the 4th grade.

At the age of 19, Aaron's spiritual journey deepened when he was baptized in Jesus' name by his father, Pastor McDowell. Together, father and son spent countless hours discussing scripture, a bond that would leave an indelible mark on Aaron's life. Around this time, Aaron also began to experience his first challenges with mental illness which he faced with courage and resilience. Turning to writing and music therapy, he channeled his struggles into creative outlets, finding solace and purpose through his art.

Aaron's passion for music was the cornerstone of his life. After graduating from high school, he pursued certifications from Berklee College of Music and the Art Institute, refining his skills in music production. In 2009, he co-founded the Copastic Music Group with close friends, performing on stages throughout the Chicagoland area. The group's hard work culminated in a major opportunity in 2012 when they opened for The Man with the Iron Fists tour, headlined by Hip-Hop legend RZA of the Wu-Tang Clan. Under the moniker "Decisive," Aaron expressed his thoughts and experiences through his creative project, Decisive Moments.

In 2012, Aaron's life was forever changed with the birth of his beloved son, Caleb. Determined to be a dedicated father, Aaron shifted his focus to his professional career. He returned to school, earning his Bachelor's in Music Production in 2015 and later his Master's in Instructional Design from Full Sail University in 2016. His academic achievements propelled him into a thriving career as an Instructional Designer, a role he excelled in for the last seven years.

Aaron's professional journey was marked by tenacity and growth from adversity. He began his career as an Office Services Coordinator at Winston & Strawn LLP in 2004 and steadily rose through various roles at Xerox, DTI LLC, and Segal McCambridge Singer & Mahoney. After receiving his master's degree, Aaron embarked on a new chapter, working with esteemed organizations like Shure Incorporated, the International Code Council, and The Scion Group, where he continued to leave his mark through his innovative instructional designs.

Despite life's challenges, Aaron was resolute in his creative spirit and unyielding focus to define his legacy. On November 24, 2024, Aaron made his transition, leaving behind a life filled with achievements, creativity, and love.

Aaron is survived by his son, Caleb McDowell; his devoted mother, Adriane McDowell; siblings Angela Richards, Larry McDowell Jr. (Shelley), Andrea Craine (Michael), Lesley McKinley, Laura Garrett (Gerrard); and a host of family, friends, and colleagues who will cherish his memory.
