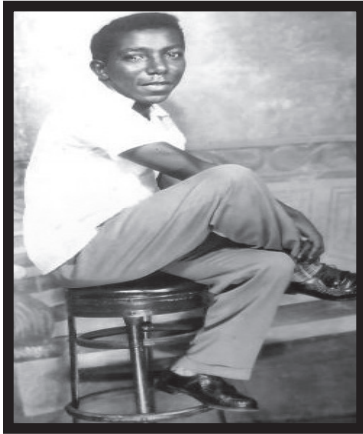

**Frank** began his working career at Spiegel Catalog Warehouse in Chicago. Frank moved to Houston,

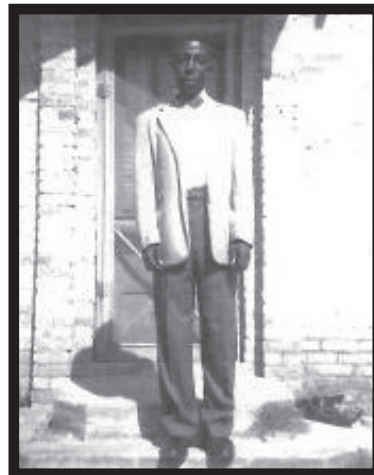
