

## *Let Me Go*

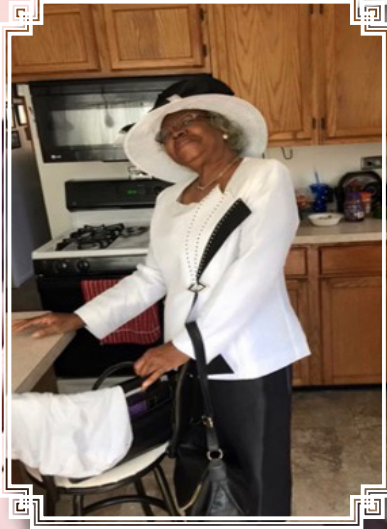
When I come to the end of the
